Welcome to Launde Abbey,

Launde Abbey has played its own unique part in English history. Established in 1119 by Augustinian monks, it has an interesting and eclectic history. Following the Dissolution of the Monasteries under Henry VIII, it was then sold to Thomas Cromwell for a very modest sum. Shortly after this, Thomas fell out of favour with the king and was beheaded for treason, thus never actually taking up residence here. As a result, his son Gregory Cromwell inherited Launde and created some of what you see today. Gregory also had connections with the king as he was married to Elizabeth Seymour (sister of Jane, Henry VIII's third wife). Gregory and Elizabeth lived here happily for many years and Gregory's tomb (found in the chapel) is now considered one of the finest examples of early Renaissance sculpture in the country.

Whilst Launde Abbey remains a Christian Retreat House, dedicated to offering a peaceful environment for prayer and contemplation, we also offer our facilities for private functions, dinner parties, weddings and also host a number of music and literary events throughout the year.
